Copaxone und LDN

Frage:

Would it be wise to take LDN and to continue with Copaxone?

If your advice is "only LDN", how long in advance of taking LDN should the Copaxone injections be terminated?

Dr. Lawrence:

In my opinion and experience, LDN is simply the best possible treatment for MS, stabilising the condition almost completely. For best response it also requires firm adherence to the routine MS diet and the usual range of nutrient supplements (see info sheets).

Copaxone may be used in company with LDN, but it contributes little if anything to the overall benefit gained. If you choose, copaxone may be stopped at anytime.

Medikinet

Frage:

Against fatigue

Medikinet 10 mg

Active Substance: Methylphenidathydrochlorid

Dr. Lawrence:

This is Ritalin, an addictive drug that should not be taken for MS.

Trevilor

Frage:

Against depression

Trevilor retard 150 mg

Active Substance: Venlafaxinhydrochlorid

Dr. Lawrence:

Familiar to me as Efexor, it is an SSRI antidepressant. As depression in MS is more precisely related to deficiencies of zinc, vanadium, the B vitamins and N3 fatty acids, it is more effective, and much safer, to replace these nutrients than to take such artificial and often harmful drugs such as these.

Chlorprothixen

Frage:

For sleeping

Chlorprothixen-neuraxpharm 50

Active Substance: Chlorprothixenhydrochlorid

Dr. Lawrence:

I am unfamiliar with this drug. It is not sold under this name in the UK. Sleep disturbance is also associated with zinc deficiency (see zinc taste test).

Frage:

Would it be wise to take LDN and to continue with the above medication?

If your advice is "only LDN", how long in advance of taking LDN should the above medication be terminated?

Dr. Lawrence:

Considering the greater effectiveness of LDN and nutrient therapy I would have no hesitation in stopping all of these drugs. None of these drugs conflict with LDN so the LDN could be started at any time, even while they are still in use.
